- I DAR membership application papers with "Record copies" which can be ordered by mail or online
- II The DAR Library
- III The Genealogical Records Committee Reports; a collection of transcriptions, cemetery surveys, and local court records, etc., which have been collected and compiled into state volumes for the past 121 years.

#### Definition of terms:

Record copy: a copy of the verified application papers of a DAR member.

Supplemental: Subsequent application papers of a DAR member for additional patriots after her initial application.

#### Navigating "dar.org" to the genealogical treasures

The easiest route is go to the home page & click on "Genealogy"

Click on "Online Research"

Highlight "GRC", the Genealogical Research System

Note the tabs across the top of the page:

Use these tabs to navigate between sections. If you find an "Ancestor" or a "Descendant" whose application papers you want to order, you can order that Record Copy here.

ANCESTOR'S SERVICES

The said John Lynch who resided during the American Revolution at <sup>PROB.</sup> Old Ninety Six District, South Carolina assisted in establishing American Independence, while acting in the capacity of a soldier

My ancestor's services during the Revolutionary War were as follows:

He served as a soldier with Roebucks in South Carolina PROB FOR MILITARY SERVICES

Give references by volume and page to the documentation or other authorities for **MILITARY RECORD**: Where reference is made to unpublished or inaccessible records of service, the applicant must file the official copy.

ELIGIBILITY CLAUSE

"Any woman is eligible for membership in the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution who is not less than eighteen years of age, and who is lineally descended from a man or woman who, with unflinching loyalty to the cause of American Independence, served as a sailor, or as a soldier or civil officer in one of the several Colonies or States, or in the United Colonies or States, or as a recognized patriot, or rendered material aid thereto; provided the applicant is personally acceptable to the Society." (Constitution, Article III, Section 1.)

Date of marriage may be substituted for dates of birth and death where such date proves the soldier to have been living during the Revolution and of a suitable age for service.

The following form of acknowledgement is required:

Applicant further says that the said John Lynch (name of ancestor from whom eligibility is derived) is the ancestor mentioned in the foregoing application, and that the statements hereinafter set forth are true to the best of her knowledge and belief.

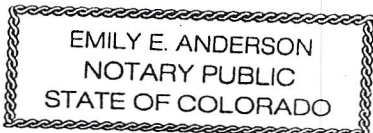
